All entries must be 2-dimensional (no 3-dimensional or glued pieces will be accepted). This year's theme is nature. Some ideas are:

Judging & Entry

Judging: Entries will be judged by members of the DDA. Art will be judged on creativity, originality, artistic quality, and visual clarity. **Entry:** Everyone may submit only one entry. Each poster must have an entry form firmly attached to the back of the poster (please no staples). Entry forms are available at downtownrome.ga.us. Entries must be postmarked or delivered to the Office of Downtown Development at 607 Broad Street, Rome, GA 30161 by 5pm on February 25. Office Hours are Monday-Friday 8am-5pm. Staff can come pick up if notified.

Rome DDA reserves the right to reproduce the posters for print and digital display, use the names/photos of the winners in public announcements about the contest, and display winning posters on public property.
