

WELCOME

The Office of Downtown Development is located in the heart of Rome. The office is nestled in the historic Carnegie building at 607 Broad Street, the Downtown Development Department of the City of Rome is fully devoted to the revitalization of the downtown district. The office serves as a point of contact for prospects, project management, grant programs, and administering the downtown revolving loan fund. The office offers many programs and services to help better the downtown community and coordinate wonderful community events in the vibrant city center, including the Downtown Saturday series and Fiddlin' Fest.

The Downtown Development Authority (DDA) was established in 1981 in accordance with the Downtown Development Authority Law.

The DDA powers include: to purchase and own property; to lease or rent; to finance projects; to receive government grants or loans: to execute contracts: to finance projects; and to receive tax monies. The DDA is primarily a policy and decision-making body and may also be a land developer, landlord, planning organization, or a project manager. The DDA board members chair five volunteer based committees: Outreach. Design, Promotions, Business Development, and Parking. DDA Board Meetings are held the second Thursday of every month in the Carnegie Building Training Room located at 607 Broad Street and are open to the public. DDA Committees also meet on a monthly basis.

DDA COMMITTEES

PROMOTIONS & OUTREACH:

THIS COMMITTEE PLAYS A KEY ROLE IN KEEPING THE BOARD, COMMITTEES AND PROGRAM OF WORK IN GOOD SHAPE BY ATTRACTING PEOPLE TO THE ORGANIZATION. WITHOUT A GOOD CORE OF VOLUNTEERS, THERE IS NO PROGRAM. ITS JOB IS TO ACTIVELY PROMOTE THE ORGANIZATION, MAKE CONTACTS, AND ENSURE A GOOD FIT BETWEEN THE REVITALIZATION PROGRAM AND THE VOLUNTEER. PROGRAMS INCLUDE COFFEE BREAKS AND NEW BUSINESS WELCOME PACKETS.

THE JOB OF THIS COMMITTEE IS TO ALSO PROMOTE DOWNTOWN AS THE CENTER OF COMMERCE, CULTURE, AND COMMUNITY LIFE FOR RESIDENTS AND VISITORS ALIKE. GOALS SHOULD FOCUS ON UNDERSTANDING THE CHANGING MARKET, IDENTIFYING DOWNTOWN ASSETS, DEFINING MARKET NICHE, AND CREATING NEW IMAGE CAMPAIGNS. RETAIL PROMOTIONS AND SPECIAL EVENTS TO LURE PEOPLE DOWNTOWN.

DESIGN:

DESIGN ACTIVITIES INCLUDE INSTILLING GOOD MAINTENANCE PRACTICES, ENHANCING THE DISTRICT'S PHYSICAL APPEARANCE THROUGH THE REHABILITATION OF HISTORIC BUILDINGS, ENCOURAGING APPROPRIATE NEW CONSTRUCTION, EDUCATING BUSINESS AND PROPERTY OWNERS ABOUT DESIGN QUALITY, AND LONG-TERM PLANNING. MEMBERS HELP TO EDUCATE BUSINESS AND PROPERTY OWNERS ON THE FAÇADE GRANT PROGRAM, HISTORIC PLAQUE PROGRAM, THE IMPORTANCE OF AN ATTRACTIVE WINDOW DISPLAY, AND SERVE AS THE LIAISON BETWEEN BUSINESSES, THE AUTHORITY AND THE CITY'S OFFICE OF DOWNTOWN DEVELOPMENT. THEY ALSO BRAINSTORM WAYS TO FURTHER ENHANCE DOWNTOWN THROUGH BEAUTIFICATION PROJECTS.

BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT:

THIS COMMITTEE HELPS CONVERT UNUSED SPACE INTO PRODUCTIVE PROPERTY AND SHARPENS THE COMPETITIVENESS OF BUSINESS ENTERPRISES. MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE LEARNING ABOUT THE DISTRICT'S CURRENT ECONOMIC CONDITION AND IDENTIFY OPPORTUNITIES FOR GROWTH; STRENGTHENING EXISTING BUSINESSES AND RECRUITING NEW ONES; FINDING NEW ECONOMIC USES FOR TRADITIONAL BUILDINGS; DEVELOP FINANCIAL INCENTIVES; AND MONITORING THE ECONOMIC PERFORMANCE OF THE DISTRICT.

PARKING:

THIS COMMITTEE COORDINATES MANAGEMENT OF THE PARKING PROGRAM, ENSURING THAT IT OPERATES AS A UNIFIED CUSTOMER FRIENDLY PROGRAM AT A HIGH LEVEL OF EFFICIENCY. TRANSPORTATION AND PEDESTRIAN SYSTEMS ARE ALSO ADDRESSED. MANAGEMENT OF THESE RESOURCES IS VERY CRITICAL TO THE VITALIZATION OF DOWNTOWN. PUBLIC AWARENESS OF THE PARKING PROGRAM IS A CRITICAL GOAL.

FUNDING

DOWNTOWN DEVELOPMENT HAS SEVERAL PROGRAMS FOR FUNDING, INCLUDING THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS DOWNTOWN DEVELOPMENT REVOLVING LOAN FUND, THE GEORGIA CITIES FOUNDATION REVOLVING LOAN FUND, AND THE CITY OF ROME REVOLVING LOAN FUND. TAX CREDITS ARE ALSO AVAILABLE.

THERE ARE ALSO OTHER RESOURCES AVAILABLE THROUGH THE OFFICE OF DOWNTOWN DEVELOPMENT, SUCH AS FACADE GRANTS, SIDEWALK CAFE PERMITS, AND THE HISTORIC PLAQUE PROGRAM. THE ROME-FLOYD CHAMBER AND UGA SMALL BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT CENTER ARE ALSO GREAT RESOURCES


THE CITY OF ROME DOWNTOWN DEVELOPMENT
AUTHORITY IS WORKING TO DEVELOP PARKING
STRATEGIES TO BETTER ENHANCE VISITOR EXPERIENCE
IN THE DOWNTOWN DISTRICT.

CURRENTLY THERE IS A 3-HOUR PARKING LIMIT FOR ON-STREET PARKING MONDAY-SATURDAY FROM 8AM-6PM.

TO PURCHASE A PARKING PERMIT YOU CAN NOW APPLY ONLINE FOR ANY OF OUR DECKS OR SURFACE LOTS. ON THE FIRST PAGE, ENTER YOUR INFORMATION, AND THEN YOU WILL BE GIVEN THE OPTION TO CHOOSE YOUR PREFERRED LOCATION. YOUR PERMIT REQUEST WILL BE SENT TO THE PARKING OFFICE FOR APPROVAL - THE PERMIT IS NOT VALID UNTIL APPROVED.

Deliveries should not be made on Broad Street between 11am-1pm. They must also be 15 feet away from a mid-block crosswalk and 50 feet from an intersection. For further details, check City Code Sec. 12-254.
